## How Do I...

### Place a hold?

If you do not see a “Place Hold” button on your current screen, look in the drop down menu which reads “Select an Action”.

### See more information on an item?

Simply click the title of the item to see all available information on an item.

### Filter my search?

After clicking the search button, use the options on the left in the blue menu to filter your search based on location, item type, and more!

## eBooks & eAudiobooks

You can now search and download OverDrive eBooks and eAudiobooks directly from the Library catalogue!

1. Search for the item you are interested in (e.g. by title, author, subject, etc.)
2. In your search results, the “eBook”  and “eAudiobook”  icons will appear beside OverDrive content.
3. Click the blue “Download” button!
4. At the “Checkout Options” menu, you can choose to download and start reading the title right away, or check it out and come back to read it later.
5. If the title is not available, you have the option to place a hold.
