



Book Club in a Bag Discussion Questions

"The Witches of New York" by Ami McKay

- 1. All three women have faced challenges in their lives that have required them to start over again. In your opinion, do any of the characters' struggles parallel modern issues?
- 2. The novel is set in the 1880s near the beginning of the suffragette movement.

 Discuss ways the characters challenge societal perceptions of women, either modern or historical.
- 3. The three women circumvent the laws by offering contraception in a period where it is illegal and considered immoral. Is their courage and determination to offer wisdom and assistance a different kind of magic?
- 4. Discuss one incident in the novel that you thought was shocking.
- 5. Discuss one aspect of the story that you thought was inspirational.
- 6. What is the significance of making the main characters witches?
- 7. Dr. Brody is a man of science, and he is intrigued by the women and their powers. Discuss the role Brody plays in the story.
- 8. In contrast, Reverend Townsend is depicted as a villain. Compare and contrast the relationship the women have with Townsend and Brody. What does this reveal about societal perceptions of women?
- 9. As Beatrice's powers grow, a division begins to manifest between Eleanor and Adelaide eventually leading to Beatrice's disappearance. What is the significance of this conflict?
- 10. McKay's fictional story is intertwined with historical events. What is the significance of Cleopatra's Needle, an Egyptian obelisk?

- Booking may be made up to a year in advance

- Pick up your hold at the circulation desk. Your notification may come in a few days early, but it will remain available until your specified pick up date.

Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit
- 6 week loan period.
- \$3.00 per day late fee.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any branch.
- Kit must be returned at the desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All 12 items are checked out to one member's card.
- The member who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
 - The distribution and return of all 12 items to his or her group members;
 and
 - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items. The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
