A Gentleman in Moscow by Amor Towles

- 1. How would you describe the Count? Was he an interesting character? Explain why.
- 2. Rostov's connections with high-ranking people reduced his sentence to being declared a "Former Person" and life imprisonment in the hotel. Do you think his sentence matched his crime? Do you think other people would have been given similar sentences?
- 3. During the novel, how did Count Rostov change? What incidents had the most effect on the Count?
- 4. The Count believes that with "the smallest of one's actions one can restore some sense of order to the world." Discuss this belief.
- 5. Why might *Casablanca* be the Count's favourite film? What does it suggest about his situation?
- 6. What picture does Amor Towles paint of the Soviet Union?
- 7. Discuss the importance of Nina's character. How has she helped the Count?
- 8. What other characters played an important part in this novel?
- 9. The Count was imprisoned for writing the poem "Where Is It Now?" What role does art play in challenging dominant cultural discourses?
- 10. If you were recommending this book to someone, how would you describe it in 3 words?

Booking a Kit

- Booking may be made up to a year in advance
- Please check the calendar accessible on our website for availability
- Fill out the form with your information, and a staff member will be in touch to confirm your booking.
- Pick up your hold at the circulation desk. Your notification may come in a few days early, but it will remain available until your specified pick up date.

Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit
- 6 week loan period.
- \$3.00 per day late fee.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any branch.
- Kit must be returned at the desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All 12 items are checked out to one member's card.
- The member who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
 - The distribution and return of all 12 items to his or her group members;
 and
 - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items. The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
