

Make Bubble Flowers!

For this activity you will need:

- 1 tbs non-toxic acrylic paint
- 1 tbs dish soap
- 2 1/2 tbs water
- 1 straw
- Shallow dish
- Watercolour paints (optional)
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Cardstock or thick paper



1. Mix 1 tbs of acrylic paint, 1 tbs of dish soap and 2 1/2 tbs of water together in a shallow dish. Stir until completely combined.
2. Place your straw in the paint mix and blow to create large bubbles.
3. Gently lower your cardstock onto the bubbles and hold it for a few seconds.
4. Remove the paper from the bubbles. Pat bubbles down with paper towel for faster drying.
5. Repeat steps 3-5 until you are happy with the pattern you've created.
6. Use markers or water colour paints to paint green leaves on a separate piece of cardstock or paper.



8. Outline stem and leaf patterns with a thin, black marker. (optional)
9. Outline painted flowers with a thin, black marker to make the flowers' details pop out more. (optional)



7. Cut out the leaves and glue them onto the bubble print flowers in any arrangement you'd like.

Make it your own!
 Blow bigger and smaller bubbles for different flower patterns!
 Make different colours of the paint mixture and print them on top of each other on the page!



CAUTION!
 Make sure your paint is non-toxic!
 Always blow out not into the straw!
 Adult supervision may be needed.

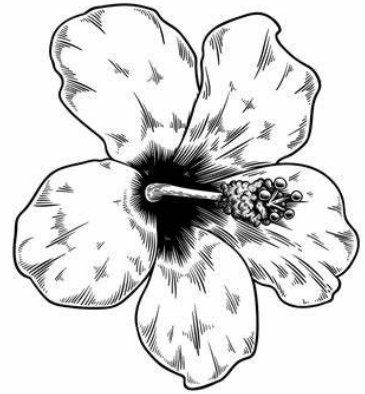
