




Fun with Lego!

For these activities you will need:

- Lego (various pieces)
- Balloons
- Elastics
- Pipe cleaners
- Bowl of water
- Paper and pencil



Lego Marble Run

Using Lego baseplates, building bricks, sloped bricks, and pins (if you want to make tipping steps), build a track that slopes down for your marble to run through.

Marble Run Tips:

- Start at the bottom and work your way up!
- Heavier marbles will work better than lighter or plastic ones.
- You don't have to use sloped bricks the whole way down, but they will help your marble gain speed.
- You can build as big or small as you want—just keep adding more baseplates to expand your track.


Lego Ring Toss

1. Start building a tower on top of a base plate.
2. Once it's the size you like, create a ring with a pipe cleaner
3. Toss the pipe cleaner ring towards your tower and see if it works.

Lego Pictionary

Gather your family to play this activity!

1. On a piece of paper, write down 20 or so different items to draw.
2. Cut out the pieces and place them in a hat or bowl.
3. Take turns choosing an item from the hat and using Lego to create the item.
4. Everyone else can try to guess the item.
5. See who becomes the Lego Pictionary champion in your household!

Lego Rainbow


For this project you will need a couple of base plates, a lot of colourful basic blocks and your imagination.

1. Take one small base plate and start to construct your rainbow as big as you want
2. Attach the second small base plate to the other side of your rainbow
3. Create clouds on the two bigger base plates.
4. Attach the rainbow to the clouds
5. Look at the rainbow you just created

Lego Boat

To make this boat you will need a bowl of water, a base plate, lots of basic blocks and a Lego person if you have it.

1. Begin with a base plate for the bottom of your boat.
2. Build up the rest of your boat using basic blocks.
2. Once you are happy with your boat, place it in a small bowl of water to see if it floats.
3. Place your Lego person into the boat and see if it still floats!



Lego Tic-Tac-Toe

1. Gather a baseplate and black blocks to build a square Tic-Tac-Toe board.
2. Next, choose 20-30 blocks each of 2 different colours.
3. Now you're ready to play—3 in a row wins!

For an extra challenge, at the end of each game, the winner can take the other person's blocks and their own. Once all the blocks are gone from the game, you can begin to build!

For an *extra, extra* challenge, convert your baseplate into a checkers or chess board!

Take a Selfie - Use a baseplate and blocks of different colours and shapes. Can you make a self portrait? What about a portrait of a family member or pet? Use your imagination and have fun!

Lego Tetris

1. Create different shapes using basic blocks
2. Once you have around 20 different shapes try to attach them together so they all fit, just like in Tetris.
3. Increase the difficulty factor with a time limit and challenge your family to see who is the best at Lego Tetris!



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
