1. Before I was an author, I taught mathematics at Oxford University and my real name was Charles Lutwidge Dodson.

2. Our invention was first flown near Kitty Hawk, North Carolina in 1903.

3. I received Pakistan's first National Youth Peace Prize for my support of girls' education.

4. I was a Mohawk (Kanien'keha) leader who fought on the side of the British Army in the American Revolution. My Mohawk name is Thayendanegea.

5. I became the Queen of England at the age of 18 and ruled for 64 years.

6. I earned a Master's degree in political economy at Harvard University before becoming a Canadian Prime Minister.

7. I began my NHL career at just 18 and was born in Cole Harbour, Nova Scotia.

8. I began my career as a journalist in Halifax, Nova Scotia before I moved to PEI to take care of my grandmother. I am best known for creating the character of Anne Shirley.

9. I worked as a social worker and elementary teacher before becoming a children's author of books such as Camp X.

10. Born in Toronto, Ontario on August 8, 1998, I became a pop music star in my teens after teaching myself to play guitar and sing by watching videos on YouTube.

11. I am the youngest in a family of 14 children. My songs have been used in the animated Beauty and the Beast and Titanic films.

12. My father was a barber. After teaching in schools I attended beauty school and after running my own salon, opened a beauty school to give black women more choices. My face is featured on a Canadian \$10 bill.
