- **Animal toys—stuffedies or plastic ones. Can be farm-themed for an extra challenge!**



Get Started!

1. Read the book [Old MacDonald Had Her Farm](#). How many vowels did you count in the story?

2. Sing the song **BINGO**:

(Clap)-I-N-G-O



5. Read along with the book [Doug Unplugs on the Farm](#).


6. Do the **Counting Feet Activity** (see the other side for instructions).
