### *A Man Called Ove: a novel* by Fredrik Backman

1. How does the opening scene, in which Ove attempts to purchase a computer, perfectly capture Ove's ongoing battle with the modern world?
2. As readers, we get to know Ove slowly as his past is revealed piece by piece. What surprised you about Ove's past? Why do you think the author revealed Ove's past the way he did?
3. Ove has been described as a cranky old man. How do his core values lead him to appear as such a grumpy individual, when, in fact, he is nothing of the sort? Which of these values do you agree or disagree with?
4. Ove is a believer in the value of routine. How can following a routine be both comforting and restrictive? In your opinion, should people try to balance routine and spontaneity, and why?
5. Which of the supporting cast (Parvaneh, Jimmy, the Lanky One, Anita) did you find yourself identifying with most?
6. Ove's is consistently facing an ongoing battle with various types of bureaucracies. Is Ove's true fight with the various ruling bodies, or are they stand-ins and scapegoats for something else?
7. On page 246, the author muses that when people don't share sorrow, it can drive them apart. Do you agree with this and why?
8. What do you think of Ove's relationship with the mangy cat he adopts? What does the cat allow him to express that he couldn't otherwise say?

### Booking a Kit

- Booking may be made up to a year in advance
- Please check the calendar accessible on our website for availability
- Fill out the form with your information, and a staff member will be in touch to confirm your booking.
- Pick up your hold at the circulation desk. Your notification may come in a few days early, but it will remain available until your specified pick up date.

### Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit
- 6 week loan period.
- \$3.00 per day late fee.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any branch.
- Kit must be returned at the desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All 12 items are checked out to one member's card.
- The member who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
  - The distribution and return of all 12 items to his or her group members; and
  - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items. The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
